**Class:** Pen & Ink with Wash and Watercolour – Drawing Dogs OR Drawing Cats

- Sketchbook
- 2B pencil
- Kneaded eraser
- One or two sheets, approx. 9 x 12", of a drawing paper suitable for pen and ink without wash. Strathmore Bristol (available in a pad) is inexpensive and recommended.
- One or two sheets, approx. 9 x 12", of Cold Press (medium texture) watercolour paper, 140 lb. Canson Montval (available in a pad) is inexpensive and recommended.
- Pigment liner or pigment ink, disposable drawing pens (made by Micron, Pilot, Staedtler, etc.). Bring at least two pens, a #2 or #3, and a #5 or #8, black ink. The smaller tips (#0, #1 or #2) are a bit delicate but you're welcome to bring one in addition to the required pens. **Ballpoint pens and felt tip pens are not suitable.**
- Your usual watercolour kit (paint, palette, brushes, water containers, masking tape, etc.) No special colours are necessary.
- Support board and bulldog clips for your paper. It is not necessary to stretch your paper. The support boards should be a little bit bigger than your paper. Don't bring oversize support boards (18 x 24").
