Class: Beginners' Watercolour

Supply List:

Bring what you have to start: e.g. paints, brushes, paper. Otherwise the recommended list of supplies is:

Paper:

- Arches 140 lb. Rough watercolour paper sheets
- or a watercolour pad with 140 lb. rough paper- 9x12 inches or a size larger.

Paint:

- Ultramarine Blue
- Burnt Sienna
- Raw Umber
- Hooker's Green
- Alizarin Crimson
- Yellow Ochre
- New Gamboge
- Sap Green
- Hooker's Green
- Golden Fluid acrylics in Titanium White & Raw Umber.

If you wish you can add a lemon yellow, cerulean blue, an orange and quinacridone red-this one makes nice pinks.

Brushes:

- Of your choice to start
- Some different sized flats and rounds including a #12 round
- #4 rigger brush

Etc:

- White Palette
- Backer Board, e.g. foam board if you have loose sheets of paper
- Masking tape to tape the sheets down with.
- Sea Sponge
- Ruler
- Pencil
