**Class:** Beginners' Watercolour

Note: At the first class, we will be talking about materials. If you are unsure about any of the items on this list we will discuss what they are, how they are used and what you should look for when buying them.

### **Supply List**

- Watercolour paper (suggested Canson 140lb, 9x12 pack of 30) or similar cold pressed
- Watercolour brushes (flat, round) to start
- 2B pencil
- Kneadable eraser
- Masking fluid (optional – may be purchased later on as well)
- Paper towel (white)
- Masking tape or green painter's tape
- Watercolour paints – you can use either Prang or a similar semi -moist palette OR a few tubes of paints with red, yellow, blue and a few others that you like
- 2 mason jars or similar for water (DVSA has plastic containers available for use in most studios)
- Palette – you can use a plastic or ceramic palette, or a simple plate for palette if you are buying tubes
- Permanent pens in your choice of colours
