**Class:** Winter Landscape Painting in Oil

**Supply List:**

- your own landscape photo(s) printed to an 8"x10" (Walmart/Fortino's/Costco)
- sketch pad, 18"x24" if you would like make a transfer
- pencils 2B, 3B
- erasers

**Canvas & Paint:**

Canvas: size to reflect your preference, and scaled up from photo reference

Paints: (artist quality/student quality). I recommend Winsor & Newton, if you opt to purchase student grade paints. Bring what you have or a good selection of primaries, secondaries and white. I am not a fan of most no name starter kits or Van Gough branded paints. Please understand that you will be frustrated using poor quality paints.

**Brushes:**

A variety of brushes would be good for this class, you may already have a preference. It is not necessary to purchase expensive brushes. Curry's brand works fine. Some other brands I use include Snap, Dynasty, Windsor & Newton & Escoda.

Make sure to have:

- an array of filbert sizes, from sizes 2 to 10
- some small rounds for detailing, sizes 0 to 2 • one 1/4" flat brush

Other supplies:

- sketch pad
- pencils 2B, 3B
- erasers
- canvas paper
- palette knife (for mixing)
- odourless mineral spirits
- linseed/walnut oil
- palette/paper paint palette
- paper towel
- Turpenoid Natural brush cleaner (this is my favourite brush cleaner, great for non-toxic clean-up)
