**Class:** Landscape Painting in Oils

### **Supply List**

- your own landscape photos printed to an 8"x10" or larger (Walmart/Fortinos/Costco)
- pencils 2B, 3B
- erasers

### **Canvas & Paint:**

- a couple medium landscape style gessoed canvas', size to reflect photo reference
- Paints: artist quality/student quality. If you opt to purchase student grade paints I prefer Winsor & Newton
- bring a good selection of primaries and secondaries, Burnt Umber, Paynes Grey and White (Titanium White or Flake White)

### **Brushes:**

A variety of brushes would be good for this class, you may already have a preference. It is not necessary to purchase expensive brushes. Some brands I use include Curry's brand, Snap, Dynasty, Windsor & Newton & Escoda.

Make sure to have:

- an array of filbert sizes, from sizes 2 to 10
- some small rounds for detailing, sizes 0 to 2
- one 1/4" flat brush

### **Other supplies:**

- sketch pad
- pencils 2B, 3B
- erasers
- canvas paper
- palette knife (for mixing)
- odourless mineral spirits
- linseed/walnut oil
- palette/paper paint palette
- paper towel
- Turpenoid Natural brush cleaner (this is my favourite brush cleaner, great for non-toxic clean-up)
