Class: Essence of the Landscape

Suggested painting equipment:

- small to medium prepared boards /canvas / painting surface (8x10 to 16x20ish) for plein air, larger for the studio (20x24, 30x36ish)
- brushes/pallet knife
- small sketchbook / pencil/ charcoal
- slide mount or small cropping 'L' arms made out of black paper
- water for painting
- palette (for acrylic painters: disposable palette pad, flat peelable plastic, or stay-wet palette)
- spritz bottle
- portable easel
- paper towels + plastic bag or two
- *Paints: I use Golden Heavy Body acrylics with generally a high degrees of transparency + GAC 100 Multi-purpose acrylic polymer. Please don't feel like you have to use my exact palette but if you'd like to try a new colour or two... here is what I'm currently packing:*
 - Hansa Yellow Light
 - Hansa Yellow Medium
 - Yellow Ochre
 - Prussian Blue
 - Manganese Blue
 - Cobalt Blue
 - Cadmium Red Light
 - Quinacridone Magenta
 - Quinacridone Burnt Orange
 - Quinacridone Nickel Azo Gold
 - Green Gold
 - Titanium White

Don't Forget:

- HAT, sunscreen, bug spray (dress accordingly)
- portable chair or stool and small folding table (optional)
- baby wipes
- bottled water, snacks
- a few bungee cords of various lengths
- if you have one....an umbrella with a clamp (to attach to your easel)
- a good shoulder bag or knapsack to carry everything
