Class: En Plein Air Sketching & Painting at Trails End Iris Gardens

Location: 3674 Indian Trail, Brantford, ON, N3T 5M1

- Travel Easel
- Canvas & Paint: several small panels or canvases for each day to make paint sketches. You may want to prepare them with an underpainting of a sepia colouring or deepened orange or grey - your choice.
- sketchbook
- Paints: (student or artist quality), what you have or a good selection of primaries, secondaries, including a variety of greens (I use sap, olive and phthalo greens), vandyke brown and/or burnt umber and white (not mixing white, I use Titanium White or Flake White)

Brushes: A variety of brushes would be good for this class, you may already have a preference. It is not necessary to purchase expensive brushes. Some brands I use include Snap, Dynasty, Windsor & Newton & Escoda and Curry's brand.

Bring what you have and also:

- bristle brushes are nice for outdoor painting
- an array of filbert sizes, from 2 to 10
- some small rounds or liners for detailing, sizes 0 to 2 • one 1/4" flat brush • one container to keep brushes in

Other supplies:

- pencils to sketch with & erasers
- small jars or pop lids for thinner and mediums
- odorless mineral spirits
- linseed/walnut oil/medium of choice
- palette/paper paint palette
- Turpenoid Natural brush cleaner (this is my favourite brush cleaner, great for non-toxic clean-up)
- paper towel
- a box or container to put wet sketches into (pizza boxes are great)

Lunch, hat, sunglasses, sunscreen, bug repellent, H2O

Shelter available, come rain or shine
