**Material list:**

**General items for comfort**

- Class is rain or shine! Please plan accordingly (umbrella, rain slicker, etc)
- Decent walking shoes, sunglasses, hat, sunscreen, bug repellent, plenty of water to drink and use in painting and clean-up
- You may want to bring a mat or a stool portable chair along with an easel
- Bring a picnic lunch
- Plastic bag to take away all your used materials. Leave the area cleaner than when you found it

**Art materials**

You may want to bring a **sketchbook** and a **camera** for recording scenes and close-up details.

- Decide on one painting medium to work with e.g. **Watercolour, oil, acrylic or pastel**
- This is a basic palette if you don't already have your own colour preferences. It consists of a warm and cool colour variation for each primary, some neutrals and colours I use specifically for landscape painting.

Ultramarine blue

Prussian blue

Cadmium red

Alizarin crimson

Cadmium yellow

Lemon yellow

Burnt umber

Ivory black

Titanium white (in watercolour can use a graphic white to paint opaquely)

Sap or olive green

For this workshop, I will be using watercolour paint to do demonstrations. You should work no bigger than 12"x16" on board, canvas or paper although you may be comfortable with 9"x12".
