- cadmium yellow
- Prussian blue
- dark purple
- cadmium orange
- green
- any other colours you'd like to use.

Note: in the student grade acrylics there may only be plain colours, they will suffice for this class. You are looking for purest looking colours as we will be mixing to make colours.

- Colour wheel
- Value chart
- Assorted brushes: round, flat, different textures. We will discuss these in the first class.
- Pencil, eraser and sharpener for sketching
- Sketch book
- Paper: XL blue book 9"x12" watercolour paper for sample work
- We will discuss substrates and mediums in the first class so it is not necessary to purchase until you know what you want and how they work
- Paper towels
- water container
- Paint palette; you can purchase palette paper, or wait until first class to see what kind of palette you might like to use. If you do not already have a palette, you can also bring wax paper to the first class to use for mixing your paints
- Plastic cover for your work space
