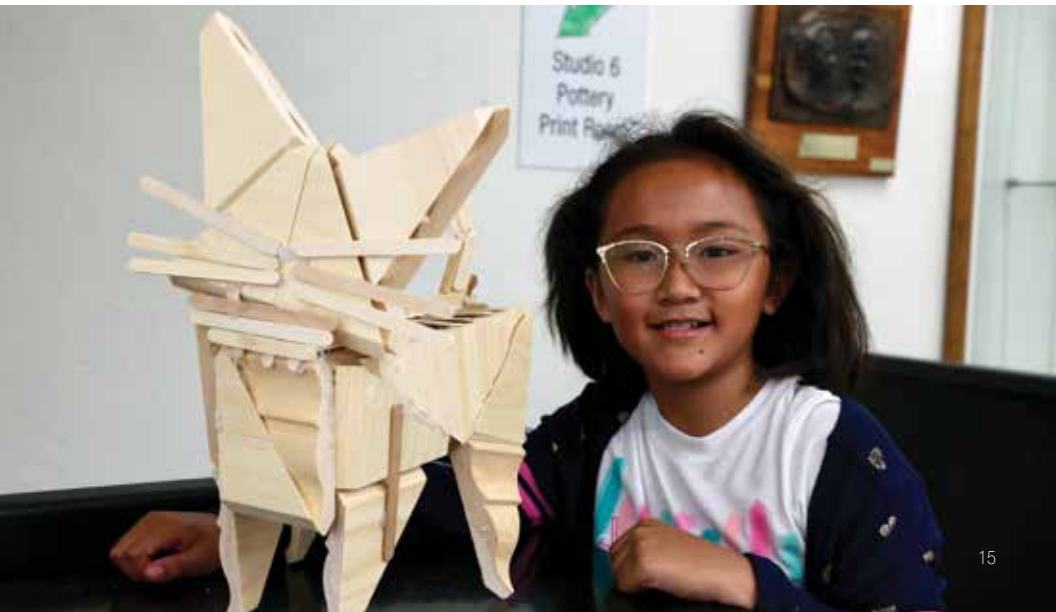
3C45 Fabric Arts Lab Ages 7+


3C48 *NEW* 2-D to 3-D: Teen Drawing & Painting Ages 11+
