1. The DVSA Gallery will exhibit _____'s (artist full name) work(s) of art.
2. The artist must assign an insurance value for each work of art. Work is insured for loss, theft and damage to a maximum of \$10,000.00. If a claim is made, the artist must produce an appraisal of value acceptable to the insurance company.
3. Work must be delivered to the gallery in good condition and ready for installation (hanging wire or hardware, etc.). Special technical requirements for installation are the responsibility of the artist. The Gallery Committee reserves the right to refuse work which it perceives as hazardous or inappropriate for the school setting. Work must be properly labelled, with one label taped to the back of the work for identification purposes, and the other attached to the front for administrative purposes. Work must not have been displayed in any previous DVSA exhibitions to be considered for the Juried Student Show.
4. Sale of artwork will be processed by DVSA. The artist will provide a sale price for each piece available for purchase during the exhibition. DVSA will charge a 20% commission on each

piece sold. Once the exhibition has ended the pieces sold will be available for pick-up by the purchaser and a cheque made payable to the artist for 80% of the sale price will be mailed within 4 weeks.

5. The submitting artist must be a student enrolled in DVSA classes over the past year. DVSA faculty members are not eligible to submit work to the Juried Student Show; however, they are invited to submit work to the annual Faculty Show.
